CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS AND VISITORS TO THE NEWCASTLE CRUISING YACHT CLUB

Section 67A of the Registered Clubs Act (NSW) provides that the Club Secretary or authorised employee of the club can remove a person from the club premises if that person:-

- a) Is intoxicated, violent, quarrelsome or disorderly, unruly, loud, belligerent or offensive in their conduct
- b) Is on the premises for the purposes of prostitution or engages or uses any part of the premises for the purposes of prostitution, or
- c) Whose presence on the premises renders the club or the Secretary of the club liable to a penalty under the Act, or Hawks, peddles or sells any goods on the premises, or
- d) Hawks, peddles or sells any goods on the premises, or
- e) Smokes, within the meaning of the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000, while on any part of the premises that is a smoke-free area within the meaning of that Act, or
- f) Uses, or has in his or her possession, while on the premises any substance that the secretary or employee suspects of being a prohibited plant or a prohibited drug within the meaning of the Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985, or
- g) Is a person whom the club, under the conditions of its certificate of registration or a term (of a kind referred to in section 76A (1) of a local liquor accord, is authorised or required to refuse access to the club.

In addition, if a person has been removed or refused admission to the club on a previous occasion, then the club secretary or an authorised employee of the club can refuse admission to or can remove that person from the club on any subsequent time they attempt to enter or are found on the premises.

In addition to the above the club requires members & visitors to dress appropriately at all times. Male members will not be admitted with singlet tops, shirts without sleeves, swimming costumes, bare feet or thongs.

Note: Sandals, sailing shoes and the like are permitted.

Ladies are required to dress appropriately at all times. Swimwear, thongs and bare feet are unacceptable.

Members and visitors are not permitted to bring any alcohol onto the premises.

In addition to the above, NCYC By Laws provide that:

Members are forbidden to reprimand staff. All complaints must be made directly to the General Manager or a Director.

Members are responsible for their guests' behaviour while on Club premises and must ensure their compliance with Club regulations.

The Clubs parking area must only be used by Members of their Guests while visiting the Club on legitimate Club business or as customers of businesses occupying Club premises. Any vehicle found not complying with this rule will be wheel clamped.

When nominating someone for membership of the Club, it is important that the nominator and seconder are confident that the nominee is a reputable person with a genuine interest in boating.

These rules should be read in conjunction with the Marina By Laws.
